## **Disaster Recovery Center in Greenville to Close**

**CRANSTON, RI.** – The Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) in Greenville in Providence County is scheduled to close on Wednesday, April 24 at 6:30 p.m.

Hours of operation: 8 am - 6:30 pm, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday.

Disaster Recovery Centers have been opened to help residents affected by the storms and flooding that occurred **December 17-19, 2023**, and **January 9-13, 2024** with the disaster assistance process.

Affected residents don't have to visit a DRC to apply for disaster assistance or to get questions answered. They can do so in in one of the following ways: Call **1-800-621-3362**. Phone lines operate from **7 a.m. to 1 a.m.** seven days a week. Help is available in most languages. If you use video relay service (VRS), captioned telephone service or others, give FEMA your number for that service. Download the <u>FEMA Mobile App.</u> (also in Spanish), available at Google Play or the Apple App Store. Online at <u>DisasterAssistance.gov</u> (also in Spanish).   6:30 pm, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday
- Cumberland Public Library, 1464 Diamond Hill Road, Cumberland, RI 02864. This is an outdoor DRC and will be operating until May 4. Hours: Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

• Knightsville Manor (Community Room), 85 Briggs Street, Cranston, Rhode Island 02920. This DRC will be operating until May 4. Hours of Operation: Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Saturday 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
