How to obtain a parking sticker for Briar Point Beach

Stickers can be purchased at the Parks and Recreation Office, 1277 Main Street, Coventry, during normal business hours. Recreation Office is open Monday thru Friday from 8:30am – 4:30pm. No stickers will be sold on site. Fee is payable by check, cash or card. Card payments are subject to a 3% fee.

Purchase of a seasonal parking sticker does not guarantee a parking spot. Parking is on a first come, first serve basis to all sticker holders.

Sticker must be attached to bottom Driver's side corner of the front or rear windshield. Sticker is valid from Memorial Day to Labor Day for the year it was issued.

Stickers are non-transferable. They may only be used for the vehicles to which they are assigned.

License plate registration of the vehicle will be recorded with Parks and Recreation and the assigned sticker must be affixed to that vehicle.

For the 2025 season, parking sticker is needed to park on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Proof of eligibility for Resident Parking Sticker:

Please Note: The Burden of Proof of Residency Falls on the Applicant.

A valid photo ID with your Coventry address listed and the current and valid vehicle registration in your name. If your photo ID and car registration addresses are different, have another proof of Coventry residency with you (utility bill, tax bill etc.) to get residency rates.

Renters: A copy of a year-round (12 month) lease and the current and valid registration of the vehicle.

Proof of eligibility for Non-resident Parking Sticker:

A valid photo ID with your current address listed and the valid vehicle registration under your name.

Replacement Stickers

Replacement stickers will be issued upon reasonable proof of loss of a sticker, or if the vehicle is traded or sold and plates transferred to a new vehicle. Only one replacement per sticker is permitted in a season. Sticker will be replaced at the original cost unless original sticker is traded in for the replacement. If a sticker has faded or failed in any way, it may be exchanged for a replacement at no additional charge.

Misuse of Stickers

At all times, the sticker remains the property of the Town of Coventry. The person to whom the sticker has been issued (pass holder) has purchased a use privilege, not the sticker and agrees that the sticker may be revoked by removal or other means if it is misused. The pass holder also agrees that the Town of Coventry will make the final judgment as to whether a sticker has been misused.

Penalties and Revocation of Stickers

Parks & Recreation Department Director may remove stickers for misuse. Persons whose stickers have been removed have five business days to appeal to the Parks & Recreation Director.
