What is recyclable in your curbside cart? Plastic, Metal, Paper, Glass

Each has their own rules; please take a moment to review them all in the next few pages.

<u>Plastics</u> – Follow the plastic rule of thumb.

It must be plastic, it must be a container; 5 gal or under. That's it!!!! NO OTHER PLASTIC, refasten covers & rinse whenever possible.

Examples of recyclable plastics:











What is recyclable in your curbside cart? Cont...

<u>Metal</u>- Follow the metal rule of thumb.

It must be Metal and either a can, a lid, or foil That's it!!!! NO OTHER METAL *Foil should be clean and bunched up.

Examples of recyclable metal:



Lids

What is recyclable in your curbside cart?

Cont.....

<u>Paper</u> – Follow the paper rule of thumb.

It must be Paper, cardboard, or a cartons That's it!!!!!! no other fiber products..

Paper and cardboard should be mostly clean and dry (a little grease on a pizza box is OK) and be flattened. Cartons must be empty at a minimum, and rinsed whenever possible.

What is recyclable in your curbside cart? Cont....

Glass – Follow the Glass rule of thumb.

It must be Glass, and either a bottle or a jar. That's it!!!! NO OTHER GLASS.

*remove metal lids and recycle separately.

Examples of recyclable Glass:





Remove the lids and rinse





NEVER PUT IN RECYCLE CART

Plastic bags

Straws

Styrofoam

Broken glass
